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**THE PINNOCHIO'S ARE PILING UP.  
IT SEEMS MOST PEOPLE DON'T SEEM TO CARE.**

In polls conducted by several news media outlets, it's been reported approximately seventy-percent of the public believe Hillary Clinton is dishonest. This number may vary somewhat depending on how the survey is worded or who specifically is surveyed, but for the sake of this article let's assume approximately thirty-percent of the public believe she is honest.

*WHO ARE THESE PEOPLE?* I have a theory.
